REVISED AGENDA FOR DTSC MEETING AUGUST 31, 2006 AT 6:30 P.M. Original Interim Measures Work Plan on Hold

Based on new information from Boeing on the Area I Burn Pit operations, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has stopped review of the Draft Revised Interim Measures Work Plan for the Area I Burn Pit (and its proposed CEQA Notice of Exemption) which was to be the subject of the meeting and hearing on August 31, 2006. Instead a public meeting will be conducted consisting of:

- A presentation by DTSC of basic background information on the Area 1 Burn Pit
- An update on the new information and how it caused DTSC to revise its interim measures approach
- Discussion of DTSC's requirement for Boeing to winterize (Winterization Plan formally called the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan) the site to minimize contaminated rainwater runoff from the Area 1 Burn Pit
- Questions and comments from the public
