The discussion topics will be:

- **SSFL Site Cleanup Status** – A brief overview of ongoing chemical cleanup activities at SSFL will be presented by the California Department of Toxic Substances Control.
- **Cleanup Agreement Negotiations** – Brief updates on letters of intent and other agreements, state law SB990, and potential listing on the National Priorities List (“Superfund list”, or NPL), will be presented by the Department of Energy, the California Department of Toxic Substances Control, the Committee to Bridge the Gap and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
- **SSFL Stormwater Discharge Permit Update** – A brief update on the status of Boeing’s stormwater discharge permit will be presented by the Regional Water Quality Control Board.
- **Radiation Survey Status** – An update on the plans for a radiation survey and status of an interagency agreement to perform that survey will be presented by U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Department of Energy.
- **Pending SSFL-Related Legislation** – A brief overview of new bills introduced in the state Assembly about possible future use of SSFL as parkland and requirements to disclose to prospective home purchasers proximity to hazardous sites will be presented by representatives of Assemblypersons Julia Brownley and Cameron Smyth.
