Dear Mr. Movassaghi,

We are stunned and dismayed to hear these continued denials from your office when clearly, from all sides, CalEPA has not been transparent or honest in its disclosure of the Consent Order Document(s) to the public. We have now been given two "altered" documents to comment on, neither of which, were the actual documents negotiated by the parties. We require answers to our questions, about the decision to remove Mr. Riley, and about the hasty decision on the part of the State to alter these documents and remove the primary party, apparently without even notifying the parties or doing so with careful review and analysis. Very basic errors appear throughout the document making it without any enforcement ability (which is its' purpose). We do not understand why you would take these short-sighted actions, without considering the fact that Boeing controls the entire site, and owns most of it, despite your claim of only 10% rad contamination which again, minimizes their role and responsibility. What is going on here? What kind of risks are you taking with our future? We have been waiting for decades for this clean-up and it seems that the State is pulling a fast one now. No wonder Boeing wants to reserve its' rights.

We hereby ask that you release the actual documents for review, and disclose exactly why these decisions were made and by whom.

We expect that you will attend the Select Committee Hearing on the 24th and that you will be prepared to answer our questions.

We expect that you will attend your own meeting for the community on 9/17/09 to "answer these questions" and provide the actual consent order in the presentation by DTSC and answer the community questions about these recent decisions made on our behalf.

We expect that you will ask Mr. Riley to attend the "Select Committee Hearing" headed by Julia Brownley so that answers to our questions can be attained about who made these decisions and why the consent order was split, leaving the primary landowner out of the mix. It is an order to perform work, how does removing the primary landowner from this order for work, compel them to do anything?
