This is a request that DTSC provide an update on the Voluntary Cleanup Agreement (VCA) that the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation entered into on September 5<sup>th</sup> of 2008 regarding the currently Closed Los Angeles City Park known as Chatsworth Park South. We are concerned about Trichloroethylene (TCE) and other Aerospace toxins that could be drawn towards this area from the daily 4300 gallons pumped out of the Southern California Rail Authority Chatsworth Tunnel No. 26 for flood controlling purposes draining into the Los Angeles River via Santa Susana Creek.
