Save Open Space (SOS) represents around one thousand residents in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties surrounding the SSFL. SOS requests that the DTSC technical team reconsider its decision on Rocky Peak for chemical background. We ask you to take into account the science as articulated in the enclosed local Simi Valley geologist's letter.

Also, we have researched the issue of the oil fields burning in the Sesnon fire and have found that the oil fields did not burn. This information came directly from an oil field employee who was there at the time and from fire reports. If you would like to call this employee to verify or see one of the fire reports, I can get this information for you.

Please promptly respond in writing to our request At the very least, please decide to do a comparison study at Rocky Peak.
